Saint Louis Music Park

FACILITY OVERVIEW

The new, state-of-the-art Centene Community Ice Center is the premier ice sports facility in the Midwest. The 277,000-square foot facility features four NHL sized ice sheets, including a 2,500 seat arena which is fully convertible for non ice sporting events, concerts, graduations and conventions. The covered outdoor rink, The Barn, features 2,200 stadium seats designed to be converted into the Saint Louis Music Park for concerts, festivals and other events during the summer months. The facility also features a performance health center, top-of-the-line technology, 20 locker rooms and multiple meeting spaces to accommodate guests of any size.

The Centene Community Ice Center has 10 meeting rooms that can be used for events, hospitality, medical staff, corporate meetings or trainings. The NHL rink has one 900 sq. ft. meeting room, that can be divided into two smaller rooms. The Plager Rink has two 900 sq. ft. meeting rooms, which can each be divided into two smaller rooms for a total of four spaces. The Mezzanine level has four meeting rooms, each 500 sq. ft. that looks over the USA Arena.

The Centene Community Ice Center opened in September 2019 and has hosted several events during that time including the St. Louis Blues Training Camp, USA Hockey Sled Classic, NHL Alumni All Star Game, Mid States High School Hockey Semi Finals, Lindenwood University NCAA games, and numerous tournaments.

The Saint Louis Music Park is scheduled to open in 2021 with multiple concerts including Blackberry Smoke, The Goo Goo Dolls, Judas Priest, Lindsey Stirling and more. The Saint Louis Music Park is also designed to host festivals, 5k's, farmers markets, and other events throughout the year. The Saint Louis Music Park also includes The Plaza, where food trucks will be located, and a turf field that enhances the versatility of the venue. The Plaza can hold up to 6 food trucks with surrounding picnic tables to accommodate guests of various sizes. The 110 x 170 turf field will be used for recreational activities including youth sports, athletic camps, fitness classes and more.






SAINT LOUIS MUSIC PARK

The Saint Louis Music Park is a 4,500 seat, multipurpose outdoor concert venue located at the Centene Community Ice Center.

The Saint Louis Music Park will make the seasonal transition from an ice skating rink to a concert venue for the spring and summer seasons. The venue features covered pavilion seating, a beer garden, an all-weather turf field, and The Plaza which will feature food trucks and seating. In addition to the many concerts, the venue will host community events, food and beer festivals, conventions, fundraisers, family entertainment, and a variety of children's programming.

Saint Louis Music Park is set to open in 2021 and will feature world-renowned acts David Gray, Blackberry Smoke, Primus, Goo Goo Dolls, Judas Priest and many more throughout its debut season.











BACKSTAGE FLOOR PLAN




RIGGING GRID




RIGGING PLAN

Doors:

The building generally opens one hour prior to event time. There is no re-entry upon exit.

Parking:

The facility property contains 600 parking spaces, with another 1,000 parking spaces at the adjacent Hollywood Casino, meant for overflow parking. There is dedicated bus parking located in an adjacent lot.

Locker Rooms:

The facility contains 20 total locker rooms. There are 8 female centric locker rooms that have private changing and shower stalls and no urinals.

Meeting Rooms:

NHL Rink has one 900 sq. ft. meeting room, which can be divided into two smaller rooms. Plager Rink has two 900 sq. ft. meeting rooms, which can each be divided into two smaller rooms, for a total of four spaces. The Mezzanine level has four meeting rooms, each 500 sq. ft. that over look the USA Arena. All of our meeting rooms can be used for events, hospitality, medical staff, etc.

Broadcast:

The Facility has broadcasting areas for all media during events. Hard line Internet streaming will be available during events and multiple camera positions with power and Internet connections.

WiFi Access:

Public and private high-speed internet access available (capable of handling heavy traffic loads, in excess of 2,000 concurrent users).
